CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made the ______ daMARef 0 7 2022 between DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT, a government agency with principal office address at IBP Road, Constitution Hills, Quezon City, Metro Manila, represented by its Undersecretary for Social Welfare and Development, DANILO G. PAMONAG, (hereinafter called the "PROCURING ENTITY") of the one part and JONECO TECH MARKETING CORP. JOINT VENTURE WITH MAXCOR INTER-VENTURES CO., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines and with office address at No. 7 Pioneer Street corner Sheridan Street Elena Roces Compound, Mandaluyong City, represented herein by its authorized representatives, VICENTE ESPERANZA III (herein called "THE SUPPLIER") of the other part;

In consideration of the payments to be made by the Procuring Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Procuring Entity to provide the goods and services and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
- 4. The Procuring Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract.
