BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) Resolution No. 20-03-070

RECOMMENDING THE USE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT THROUGH EMERGENCY CASES AND AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 3,000 UNITS OF SOLAR POWERED LAMPS (PORTABLE) FOR THE FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE TAAL VOLCANO ERUPTION (PR NO. 01-20001-PR-2020-03-00079)

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in its efforts to provide immediate protection and disaster relief operations brought about by the Taal Volcano eruption, has been monitoring and unceasingly working on strategies to quickly respond to the needs of the possible disaster stricken-communities;

WHEREAS, the National Resource and Logistics Management Bureau (NRLMB), submitted an approved Purchase Request (PR) Nos. 01-20001-PR2020-03-00079 for Emergency Procurement for the Supply and Delivery of 3,000 units of Solar Powered Lamps (Portable) for the Families Affected by the Taal Volcano Eruption. The approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is Four Million Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 4,800,000.00). A copy of the said PR is hereto attached, marked as Annex "A", and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Justification signed by Director Emmanuel P. Privado of National Resource and Logistics Management Bureau (NRLMB), there is an urgent need to procure the 3,000 units of Solar Powered Lamps (Portable). A copy of the said justification is hereto attached, marked as Annex "B", and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, considering the urgency of the aforesaid request and following the market research conducted by NRLMB, the Procurement Management Service (PMS), through the Procurement Planning and Management Division (PPMD), immediately prepared Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. 20-0327 NP-Emergency and sent to thirty (30) suppliers. A copy of Request for Deliveration/Evaluation of the said RFQ with the list of suppliers that has been invited is hereto attached, marked as Annex "C", and made integral part hereof:

WHEREAS, all efforts have been exerted however, only the following suppliers submitted their price quotations within the set deadline on March 19, 2020 at 09:00 a.m.

- Use of Negotiated Procurement Emergency Cases for the Supply and Delivery of 3,000 units of Solar Powered Lamps (Portable) for the Families Affected by the Taal Volcano Eruption, pursuant to Section 53.2 of the 2016 Revised RIRR of RA No. 9184; and
- Award of contract to the technically, legally and financially capable supplier for each item per RFQ No. 20-0327 NP-Emergency according to the following:
