BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE (BAC) Resolution No. 20-04-081

RECOMMENDING THE USE OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT THROUGH EMERGENCY CASES AND AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 2,500 PIECES OF DSWD VESTS FOR THE USE OF CENTRAL AND FIELD OFFICE STAFFS SUPPORTING OPERATIONS AND CONDUCTING DISASTER RELIEF OPERATIONS (PR NO. 01-20001-PR-2020-03-00294)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Proclamation No. 922 entitled "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines", all National Government Agencies and Local Government Units are enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation and mobilize the necessary resources to undertake critical, urgent and appropriate response and measures in a timely manner to curtail and eliminate the Corona Virus Disease (Covid-19) threat. A copy of the said Proclamation No. 922 is hereto attached, marked as Annex "A", and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in consonance with the Proclamation No. 922, and in its efforts to formulate programs, projects and measures for the social amelioration of affected workers and residents of the areas subjected to Enhanced Community Quarantine amidst the Covid-19 crisis, the Disaster Response Management Bureau (DRMB) requested an emergency procurement of 2,500 pieces of DSWD Vests under Purchase Request (PR) No. 01-20001-PR-03-00294 for distribution to the Central and Field Office Staffs on the field providing support to the operations and conduct of disaster relief operations, with an Approved Budget for the Contract amounting to Three Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP3,750,000.00). A copy of the PR is hereto attached, marked as Annex "B", and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, Section 53.2 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA No. 9184) otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, allows the use of Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases whereby the Procuring Entity can directly negotiate a contract with a technically, legally and financially capable supplier. Negotiated Procurement-Emergency Cases may be resorted on the following instances;

- i. In case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity, or
- ii. When time is of the essence arising from natural or man-made calamities or
- iii. Other causes where immediate action is necessary:
 - a) To prevent damage to or loss of life or property, or
 - b) To restore vital public services, infrastructure facilities and other public utilities.

WHEREAS, the DRMB submitted a justification requesting for emergency procurement of 2,500 pieces of DSWD Vests. Likewise, the said procurement request is in compliance with the directives of the Secretary on wearing of the DSWD Vest during the conduct of disaster relief operations to further strengthen the Department's overall identity



and easier identification of staffs on the field. A copy of the Justification is hereto attached, marked as **Annex** "C" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in the exigency of service and considering the urgency of the aforesaid request and to ensure that competitive prices are obtained, the Procurement Management Service (PMS), through the Procurement Planning and Management Division (PPMD), immediately prepared the Request for Quotation (RFQ) No. 20-0352 NP-Emergency Cases for the 2,500 pieces of DSWD Vests and sent to the following prospective suppliers, to wit:

 Use of Negotiated Procurement - Emergency Cases for the Supply and Delivery of 2,500 pieces of DSWD Vests, pursuant to Section 53.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, for distribution to the Central and Field Office Staffs for easier identification of the staff on the field providing support to the operations and conduct of disaster relief operations; and



2. Award of contract to HAPPY BOUTIQUE, being the technically, legally and financially capable supplier, with a total contract cost amounting to Three Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (PhP3,250,000.00), inclusive of applicable taxes for the Supply and Delivery of 2,500 Pieces of DSWD Vests for the use of Central and Field Office Staffs Supporting Operations and Conducting Disaster Relief Operations.
