II IMPORTANT NOTE: Detailed specifications must be provided. Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of ITB Clause 3.1(a)(ii) and/or GCC Clause 2.1(a)(ii).

II. Qualifications

The Service Provider must:

- 1. Submit a company profile highlighting number of years in the business, past projects, and contact persons and numbers of previous clients who can certify their past projects. They must also submit at least five (5) samples of videos developed and produced as basis of evaluation. The firm must also identify a representative, who shall coordinate with the Social Marketing Service (SMS) and Disaster Response Management Bureau (DRMB) staff and shall be responsible in ensuring that all deliverables are met on time.
- 2. Have experienced writers who can develop the scripts; make the materials concise yet comprehensive; explicit yet reader/audience friendly; and creative yet unconventional. They must have superior writing skills; proficient in every aspect of writing; at least five (5) years experience and proven track record particularly, conceptualization/writing of IEC materials and/or scripts. He/she must submit sample works, which will be one of the bases of evaluation.
- 3. Have complete video production staff with at least five (5) years experience in development and production of audio visual materials. The service provider will support and oversee the whole production of instructional videos and ensure quality control.
- 4. Have the capacity to develop, produce instructional videos. They must submit at least five (5) sample videos developed.

III. Scope of Work and Deliverables

The service provider shall provide the DSWD with services relative to the development and production instructional videos. Specifically, the service provider shall:

a. Attend the meetings with the DRMB and SMS;

- b. Provide the following key personnel: project manager, writer, photographer, editor, and full video production crew;
- c. Prepare the concept of instructional videos in consultation with the DRMB and SMS. They must submit at least three (3) proposed concepts;
- d. Prepare concept, develop, and produce four
 (4) instructional video materials specifically on the following:
 - 1. DSWD DRRM Efforts;
 - 2. Risk Resiliency Programs;
 - 3. Camp Coordination and Management highlighting Comprehensive Emergency Protection for Children; and
 - 4. Early Recovery Services, in consultation with the DRMB and SMS. Location shooting will be in Marawi, Tacloban, and Metro Manila. (Please see the technical specifications of video modules)

Specifically, the service provider is expected to provide the following:

- Concept Development this includes presentation of outline and script of the video modules;
- Complete video and support staff, and pre and post production equipment;
- Complete Photography Gear; and
- Talents (voice over and actors and actresses as needed for the video modules)

The service provider will have the following qualifications/tasks:

- a. At least five (5) years' experience and proven track record on video production;
- b. Must be able to provide at least five (5) related samples of work.
