**REVOCATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 22, SERIES 2004,  
REVISING THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES  
OF THE "PGMA-PAYATAS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM"**

---

In the exigency of the service and in recognition of the government's commitment to provide educational assistance to the children/youth victims of the July 10, 2000 landslide tragedy in Payatas, Administrative Order No. 22, series 2004, is hereby revoked effective immediately.

The program shall henceforth be known as the "PGMA-Payatas Educational Assistance Program," which is intended to benefit four hundred (400) students every year. Considering the socio-economic realities of the intended beneficiaries of the program, the grade requirement shall be a passing general weighted average (GWA) at the end of every school year.

Funds for the project shall be sourced from the Presidential Social Fund (PSF) of the Office of the President under the administration of H.E. President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, donations, and other fund sources which may be identified by the Department.

Department Administrative Order No. 1, series 2002, is hereby amended accordingly.
