ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SUBJECT: Reporting System for Non-Government Organizations (NGOs)

Social Welfare and Development (SWD) Programs/Services

Implementation

I. BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

Executive Order No. 15 (Redirecting the Functions and Operations of the Department of Social Welfare and Development) issued in 1998 spells out among others, the Department's role of being the "lead line agency and authority in formulating national social welfare and development policies, plans, programs, and statistics, especially as these relate to family development and poverty groups." With this statement, it is a must that DSWD initiate the generation, integration and analysis of relevant Social Welfare and Development (SWD) statistics and reduce them in desired form to serve as basis of policymakers, planners and program developers in their decision making efforts.

In order to come up with a universe SWD data, there is a need to develop a mechanism that will capture and reflect the NGO performance relative to SWD programs/services implementation. The NGO Reporting Form was developed in coordination with Standards Bureau and the National Council for Social Development (NCSD). This reporting form was formulated based on the existing DSWD Major Final Outputs Reporting Forms.

Last August 5-6, 2004, a consultation of the NGO Reporting System, to include the form and the process of submission, was conducted to NGOs operating in more than one region with main offices in Regions III, IV and NCR and representing all types of client categories. The conduct of the orientation was necessary to solicit their support and cooperation and secondly to ensure uniform interpretation of terms, concepts, and processes included in the system. The participants find the reporting form easier to accomplish, simple and very useful in the reporting of their accomplishments. Based on the agreements during the orientation, the Policy and Plans Bureau revised the reporting system to include their comments and suggestions. The provisions in this guideline include the agreements reached during the consultation.

II. SCOPE

This guideline covers only accredited/licensed NGOs nationwide, in order to highlight their accomplishments/contributions on Social Welfare and Development sector.

III. OBJECTIVES

General: To come up with a universe SWD data by capturing the NGO performance relative to SWD programs/services implementation.

Specific:

- 1. To highlight the other partners contribution specifically the NGOs relative to their implementation of SWD programs/services
- 2. To acknowledge and put premium in the accomplishments of NGOs.
- 3. To be the basis for future action, direction and policy formulation of the Department along SWD implementation by the NGOs.

IV. THE NGO REPORTING FORMS

The reporting forms for NGOs SWD programs/services implementation shall be composed of the following forms:

Center-Based

Refers to the services provided to the client in a regular physical structure or "center", which operates only for a specified number of hours a day.

NGO Center-Based Plan/Served (Form 1)

This form is a tool to gather data/information on the physical targets and accomplishments/served of the NGOs operating in a center-based relative to their SWD programs/services implementation. The plan shall be done annually while the accomplishments/served is on a semestral basis, disaggregated by sex, by age and by client category such as children, youth, and adults in need of special protection. This would also include the interventions/services rendered to client, those discharged as a result of the impact of interventions/services to client and clients still in care.

Community-Based

Refers to the services provided to the client in his or her home or in the community in which he or she lives. An additional feature of this delivery mode is community interaction or participation in client activities and management

NGO Community-Based Plan/Served (Form 2)

This form is a tool to gather data/information on the physical targets and accomplishments/served of the NGOs operating in community-based relative to their SWD programs/services implementation. The plan shall be done annually while the accomplishments/served is on a semestral basis, disaggregated by sex, by age and by client category such as children, youth, adults in need of special protection and disadvantaged/marginalized families to include the interventions/services rendered to these client.

V. Institutional Arrangement

In order to put this reporting system in place, the following institutional arrangements shall be observed:

Policy and Plans Bureau

- Monitor, consolidate and analyze the reports submitted by NGO Head Office every semester;
- o Provide technical assistance to FOs/NGOs when necessary;
- O Provide a national report with analysis to the management and other users of report every semester for their information and appropriate action.

> Standards Bureau

- Assist in the monitoring of compliance of NGOs in the submission of the reporting form;
- Ensure the use of this reporting form to all NGOs--old and newly accredited/licensed, thus, to include this in the requirements for accreditation and licensing.

DSWD Field Offices

Standards and Regulations Unit

- Provide/disseminate to the NGOs the reporting forms;
- Monitor the reports submitted by NGOs every semester
- Provide technical assistance to NGOs when necessary; and
- Coordinate, ensure submission of reports by NGOs.

Policy and Planning Unit

Consolidate, analyze and process the reporting forms submitted by NGOs to be used for their own planning development and policy formulation. No need for DSWD-FOs to submit consolidated reports to DSWD-CO since the NGO Head Office will directly submit their report to DSWD-CO, copy furnished DSWD-FO concerned.

> Non-Government Organizations

- Accomplish the forms applicable to their type of operation (i.e. center-based or community-based) and only to the client category they being served (i.e. children, youth, other adults in need of special protection and disadvantaged/marginalized families).
- NGO Regional Office to submit their report (statistics and narrative) to their Head Office copy furnished the DSWD Regional Office concerned.
- o NGO Head Office to consolidate reports of their regional offices and submit to DSWD Central Office (statistics and narrative) thru Policy and Plans Bureau.

VI. Frequency of Submission and Flow of Report

The NGO Regional Office shall accomplish either Form – 1 or Form 2, depending on the type of their operation (center-based and community based) both for planning and reporting of accomplishments. The plan shall be done once a year while the accomplishments/served will be on a semestral basis. These shall be submitted to their NGO Head Office, copy furnished the DSWD-Field Office concerned. The NGO Head Office will then validate and consolidate the submission of their regional offices and for onward submission of the Consolidated National Report of the NGO to DSWD-CO thru Policy and Plans Bureau, deadline of submission are as follows:

Annual Plan - every end of March of the planning year Semestral Accomplishments -20 days after the reference semester

- > 1st Semester on or before July 20
- ≥ 2nd Semester on or before January 20

Policy and Plans Bureau shall process and consolidate the national reports of NGOs received to come up with the Consolidated SWD Programs/Services Implementation of Different NGOs for the reporting period. The consolidated report together with an analysis and recommendation will be submitted to Management for their information and action when needed, and other internal

and external users . Please refer to Annex A for the Data Flow Diagram of NGO Reports.

VII. **Effectivity**

This Order takes effect immediately and revokes other previous orders inconsistent thereof.


