Administrative Order No. <u>0</u>4 Series of 2014

Amendment to Administrative Order No. 15 Series of 2010 otherwise known as, the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Social Pension for Indigent Senior Citizens

1. Rationale

The Social Pension for indigent senior citizens is being implemented through the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) since January 2011 in all regions, nationwide. The initial target beneficiaries was based on the 1,043,745 list poor households with senior citizens based on the National Household Targeting System for Poverty Reduction (NHTS-PR) 2009 data.

However, considering the period of three (3) years of Social Pension implementation, the NHTS-PR list was already utilized. It can also be noted that not all the poor / indigent senior citizens are included in the NHTS-PR 2009 list of poor senior citizens. In addition, the provisions under AO 15 series 2010, requires some necessary changes. Hence, this amendment. Further, it is stated in the special provision under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for CY 2014 that, "the "amount of PhP3,108,913,000 appropriated for Social Pension for indigent senior citizens shall be used exclusively for the monthly stipend of PhP500 to senior citizens registered in the NHTS-PR, as validated by the LGUs."
